#### **SELF-HAUL REGISTRATION**

### **Background Information**

All generators in unincorporated San Diego County are required to comply with recycling requirements of the County Code. These requirements include separating and recycling designated recyclable and organic materials. Generators may comply by subscribing to waste, recyclable, and organic materials collection services from a qualified provider, unless the premises' responsible party is granted a waiver, registers as a self-hauler, or meets exemption criteria of the County's municipal code.

### **Who May Register**

Owners, occupants, or operators of any multi-family/commercial premises, as well as single-family premises that generate one cubic yard or more per week of discarded materials and self-haul designated recyclable and/or organic materials to a facility that reuses, salvages, recycles, or processes the materials.

In order for a self-haul program to be deemed sufficient, <u>all</u> designated recyclable and/or organic materials listed on page 2 shall be included in the program and may not go to landfill. Additionally, registration is required for those who contract with landscaping services who haul green materials from where they are generated. Registered self-haulers with a sufficient diversion program do not need to subscribe to service with a franchise hauler.

# Self-haul Requirements (San Diego County Code, Sec 68.572)

- Self-haulers shall handle discarded materials by source separating materials into three or more streams including designated recyclable materials, designated organic materials, and solid waste.
- Maintain an annual log documenting the types and quantities of discarded materials generated and delivered to recycling facilities, organic waste facilities, solid waste facilities, salvage operations, or other locations.
- The annual log shall be maintained in a form or format as prescribed by the Director for the preceding fiscal year July 1 through June 30.
- Annual logs shall be stored for a period of three (3) years at the place of business in the unincorporated areas of the county for multi-family and commercial premises and at the place of residence in unincorporated areas of the county for single-family premises and shall be made available to County inspector upon request.
- At a minimum, the annual log shall include the following:
  - Delivery receipts and weight tickets from the entity accepting designated recyclable materials, designated organic materials, and solid waste;
  - The amount of material in cubic yards or tons transported by the owner, occupant, or operator to each entity; and,
  - If the material is transported to an entity that does not have scales to weigh the materials onsite or employs scales incapable of weighing the self-hauler's vehicle in a manner that allows it to determine the weight of the materials delivered to the facility, the self-hauler is not required to record the weight of material, but shall keep an invoice from facility estimating weight or volume from the facility that received the designated recyclable materials, designated organic materials, and solid waste.

### Recycling requirements in densely and sparsely-populated areas

Densely-populated areas of the County are those with census tracts with 75+ people per square mile.



#### To be considered for the self-haul program, the registrant agrees to the following:

- 1. Self-hauler will notify the County if circumstances change such that they no longer self-haul materials, in which case registration will be considered void and registrant will subscribe to services with a franchise hauler.
- 2. Self-hauler must cooperate with the County and/or designee for compliance inspections and enforcement as stated in County Code Section 68.610.
- 3. Self-hauler acknowledges that noncompliance is subject to an Administrative Citation with escalating penalties.
- 4. County may revoke self-haul registration upon determination that the self-haul program is insufficient.
